You will need:

- 3 matchboxes
- Coloured paper
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Crayons and stickers for decorating
- 3 jewel stickers

Instructions

- Glue the 3 Matchboxes together so they stack up and the drawers still open
- 2.Cut out a piece of coloured paper to wrap around the boxes
- 3. Glue the paper onto the boxes
- 4. You could also cut out paper to stick on to the front of the drawers like we've done
- Decorate your drawers with crayons and stickers
- 6. Decide what you will put in you box, then fill the drawers with your favourite things (we've put pennies, buttons and shells in ours!)
