

Walk directions



Directions

Distance: 2.25 miles (3.6 kms) from Bath Abbey

Duration: Approximately 1 hour

Terrain: Mainly uphill on pavements

From Bath Abbey, walk through the courtyard and turn left into Westgate Street.

At the junction turn right up into Saw Close. Pass the Theatre Royal on your left and ahead up along Barton Street.

Continue ahead into Queen Square up Gay Street and turn left in The Circus.

Turn left along Brock Street. Continue around the Royal Crescent to Marlborough Buildings (Road).

Turn right up the road and walk up Cavendish Road. Continue along to meet a junction with Sion Hill. *

Cross and continue ahead into Winfred's Lane. Continue up to meet a junction with Sion Road and Hermitage Road.

Continue ahead into Sion Road and follow until you reach Lansdown Road.

Turn left into Lansdown Road and follow for approx 1 mile (1.6km) passing Kingswood School on the left.

Arrive with Beckford's Tower and Museum on your left.

* Should you wish to visit where Beckford lived on Lansdown Crescent turn right onto Sion Hill and walk to Lansdown Crescent. *He lived at No.19 and No.20 by the archway.*

Beckford's ride started at the Embedded Gateway, you can view this from the pavement if you go through the arch at Lansdown Crescent and along Upper Lansdown Mews.

To get back to the main route, go back the way you came and turn right onto Somerset Place. At the end of the road turn right onto Winfred's Lane.
